- C. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:
- **1. Plaza 88 report:** Allan: Still no word on McInnis overpass with reconfiguration and construction. We have asked and continue to ask for participation in the process. Carnarvan is much better these days with less crime, safer and cleaner environment. Waiting for word on the opening of the Bus Loop. We need more information from the city. The first floor of Plaza 88 is designed for live work studios.

- **5. Poplar Landing Development:** Allan: Council has asked for expressions of interest for the property at a recent council meeting for social housing.
