Re: Quayside Esplanade Boulevard Tree Pruning

Please be advised that the City of New Westminister, Parks Arboriculture Division, will be commencing tree pruning work on the boulevard trees located along the upland side of the Quayside esplanade between Quayside Park and the foot of 10th Street.

Work is scheduled to commence on April 24 and may take up to three weeks to complete. Crews will be working on weekdays between approximately 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

The purpose of the tree pruning is to manage the overall health of the trees and maintain view corridors towards the river. The scope of work will include crown cleaning, directional pruning (as part of a young tree training program), and raising of the tree canopy. In addition, two damaged esplanade boulevard trees at 3 K de K Court will be replaced.

While this work is taking place, small portions of the esplanade walkway may be intermittently closed for public safety purposes. Access along the river frontage will be maintained at all times but may occasionally require the use of the wooden boardwalk section of the esplanade.
