3. City Updates:

a) Quayside Park

The Parks Department is finalizing the drawings for the redevelopment of Quayside Park. There is a proposal to use a pour-in-place rubberized surface in portions of the playground and custom play equipment.

b) Carnarvon Tower

The new development on Carnarvon is being reviewed. An Open House is planned May 4th.atTrinity Church Hall.

c) Bike Race

Tentatively scheduled on July 11, 2017. The proposed racing course includes parts of Columbia Street, Eighth Street, Carnarvon Street, Sixth Street, and Begbie Street. For more information see.

G. New Business

1. Water Shut Off

Paul raised concerns about how the city information was distributed. Late notice of the shut-down affected Excelsior as did the quick turn on. Paul asked if the city has a process for contacting strata during on-going projects.

2. Parking Survey

The city will be conducting a Parking Survey to evaluate on street parking along Quayside. The results will be shared with the committee.

3. Coal Port Update

James mentioned the Province is looking at restricting the shipment of US Coal through the Port.

H. Strata Gems

A good discussion took place on No Smoking Bylaw options. Dockside shared their current bylaws. Other strata are reviewing options especially once Marijuana is legalized.

I. Correspondence received

- a) Drones A resident at 6 Renaissance Court copied the QCB on a letter asking the City to install "No Drone" signage. While the area west of the Condo's is public, the launching and flying drones along the Boardwalk contravenes current Federal Aviation Rules.
- The QCB received an email from Erika Mashing, Parks and Open Space b) **Grant** Planner, asking to support their application to the Tire Stewardship Program of BC for external funding for the rubberized surface in the playground area of the Quayside Park. Vickie and James will follow-up. A sample letter from Qayqayt Elementary was provided.
