Subject: High Streamflow Advisory for Fraser River

- The Fraser River at Mission is currently running at about 11,400 cu. m/sec, and is expected to peak in excess of 12,000 cu. m/sec (https://wateroffice.ec.gc.ca/report/real_time_e.html?stn=08MH024).
- The BC River Forecast Centre is forecasting levels to approximately 6.72m at the Mission Gauge (http://bcrfc.env.gov.bc.ca/freshet/lower_fraser/LFR-10-DayFloodLevelForecasts.pdf) on Monday May 21, 2018<file://enterprise/perimeter/pimdata/messages/1491429875/4/9/msg-o1rbop>. Today it peaked at 5.81m.

- o Dyke patrols will begin on the morning of Saturday May 19

- o Approximately 2,000 small burlap sandbags will be produced at the Works Yard by the end of today. They will be palletized and will be placed at vulnerable locations once identified including the rail bridge at the Quay. Large sandbags will be made by WinVan.

- o Kruger Products, Braid Industrial Area and the mainland under the SRY bridge are identified as vulnerable areas. We will be stockpiling sandbags in the vicinity.

- o Defender logs have been catching debris.
- o Beach at Port Royal belongs to the Port Authority but signage will be put up advising caution.
